Saturday- August 30 - West end yachts will meet at Babylon Y.C. at 10 AM and sail leisurely down to Bellport

Sunday August 31 - BELLPORT Y.C. HANDICAP RACE

Same classes, same time allow. for West Island Race. Start off Y.C. dock. Warning gun at 1250, Prep at 1255, Class C at 1300, Class B at 1305, Class A at 1310. Course leave Howell's Pt Black flasher to STBD, round the Blue Point Black Flasher #31 to EITHER side, return to Bellport Y.C. leaving Howell's Pt flasher to PORT.

Monday - Labor Day- WET PANTS ASSOC HANDICAP RACE - SAYVILLE

Commencing at 2 PM just a lot of fun, frolic, boozin' and snoozin'...a real family day. This basin has been dug out of the green marsh that shows on your chart just east of the Cherry Grove C.G. Station. The channel is staked and runs from N.E. to S.W.-leave stakes to port entering...5 feet depth in channel. You can't anchor. Bring plenty of fenders because fleet will have to nest in groups of 3 or 4 alongside the docks. Completely sheltered. There are no supplies available except firewood.
