

RACING CIRCULAR

CB&S CLUB 14TH ANNUAL CREEPSTAKES

May 21, 1960

- Requirements: Vessels must be bona-fide cruising auxiliaries, sailed with skipper only on board.
- Entries: Enclosed postcard must be in Commodore Raymond's hands pronto--no later than May 10. Leave space at lower left for his nefarious "calculations".
- Prizes: Purely at the discretion of the CB&SC Commodores and Guaranteed not to fit any existing trophy shelf.
- Starting Line: Between Red Nun 26 off Green's Ledge Light and Committee Boat.
- Warning Gun: 0950 (DST) First Numeral Pennant
- Preparatory Gun: 0955 (DST) Second Numeral Pennant
- Start: 1000 (DST) Third Numeral Pennant

Pennants will be lowered 30 seconds before following gun.

- Course: From starting line to Can 13 off Eaton's, to Flashing Red Whistle 32A, to finish line, leaving all marks to starboard.
- Reverse Course Signal: Blue Peter
- Finish: Between Red Nun 26 off Green's Ledge Light and Committee Boat.
- Postponement: 15 minutes -- International Flag George
- Time Limit: 1800 (6 PM DST) for first boat to finish
- Restrictions: No spinnakers. Yachts must race in cruising trim. Engines must be in operating condition, carry sufficient fuel to permit returning to the starting line under power from any point on course.
- Short Course: A shortened course may be announced by Committee Boat at the first mark.

Spectator Boats will leave Norwalk Yacht Club 9:15 AM. Please have spectators bring their own lunches, beverages, and life preservers.

Dinner: At Lyons Pier, starting about 6 PM. Please limit reservations to four per boat.
