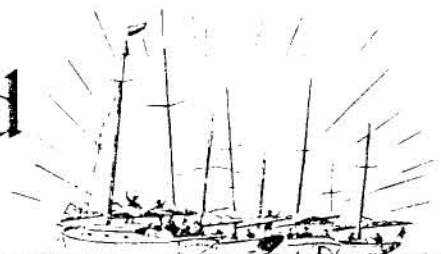

RACING SCHEDULE UP TO JULY 4, 1964

JUNE 14, JUNE 21.

Those members belonging to the Babylon Yacht Club can participate in this intra-club series.

JUNE 20 BAY SHORE INVITATION

This is the 12th invitation from our good friends at the Bay Shore Yacht Club and has always been the kick-off race for the season. Some skippers have been seen to wait until the starboard tack to complete hull painting.

Warning gun at 13:00, Start by classes. Starting line in the vicinity of Lawrence Creek, thence west to Nun #6, keeping it on the port hand to RF #4 off Nicoll Point, return to finish line leaving FL G #1, off Bayberry Point, to starboard.

JUNE 26, LADIES RACE, OFF BABYLON Y.C.

On this day the ladies have the con. Their mates may work the sheets and offer advice but dare not touch the helm on the pain of a DSQ. Start off the club area at 14:00 thence to the Oak Beach Flasher keeping it on the port hand, through the center span of the bridge to NUN #6, rounding on the port hand and finish off the BYC regatta stand. Start by classes and results handicapped. Do come. Rendezvous at the B.Y.C. and b.y.o.b.

JULY 4, BABYLON INVITATION

This is the oldest invitation race offered to the SBCC and usually commands a good turnout for it is an interesting course. Starts in the Babylon Cove are dependent on winds and you will observe the following instructions which will be displayed by number from the Committee Boat "SUNARA". You should also obtain a race chart from the Babylon Y.C. (this will be in the GSBYRA Year Book) so that you can identify the race markers in the area.

The Race Committee has the option of keeping the finish mark on the same side as it was at the start. Look for it. The area, while it lies clear of the Class boats line "D" to "A", will be alive with small boats so keep clear when finishing and returning to the Yacht Club. Cruising Yachts are requested to keep clear of the dock and anchor off. Tender service will be available.

To repeat NAYRU instructions Yachts not about to start will keep clear of the line until the starting class is over.

Warning Gun 13:00, Prep Gun 13:05, Class "C" starts at 13:10 and "B", "A", and "S" at five minute intervals.
