It's hard to believe that it's time to say 'Farewell' as Fleet Captain. I have thoroughly enjoyed my tenure these past two years. I must thank each and every one of you who has supported me by hosting a rendezvous, being a cruise captain, participating in the cruise and rendezvous program, or by being part of my Cruising Committee. The program would not have been what it was without each of you! Please support Della Bucher as she takes the helm as Fleet Captain for the next two years. I know she is well on her way to completing the Rendezvous list for the 2008 season! It's those last 4 or 5 rendezvous that are the toughest to fill. Phoebe Rose is now out of the water and on the hard. She took us to places we have never been before by boat, and she took us back to places we have been to before. Most of our travels have been to SBCC rendezvous and SBCC cruise destinations. We'll take a break from boating for a season, but soon we'll be looking forward to next season, because every sun rise from here on in is one day closer to the boat going back in the water.....

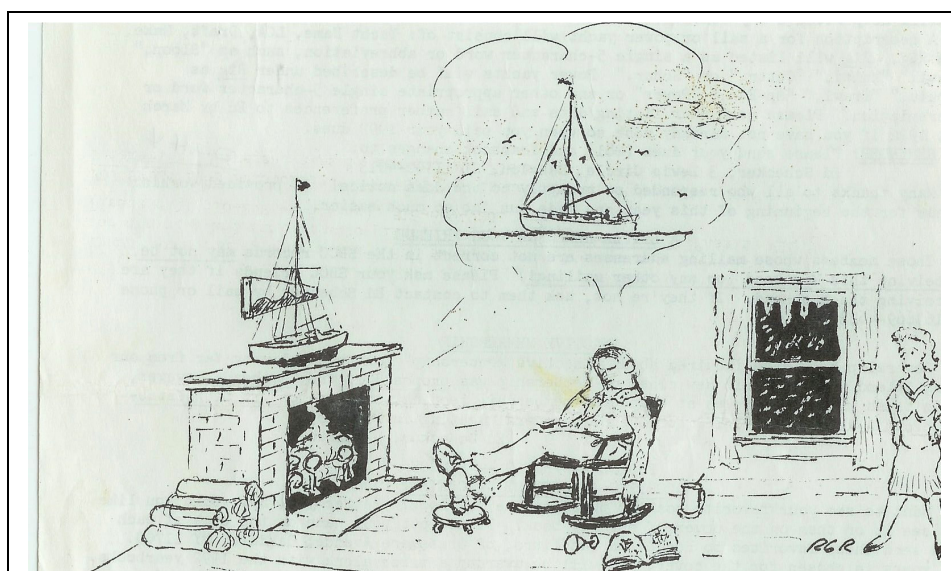
