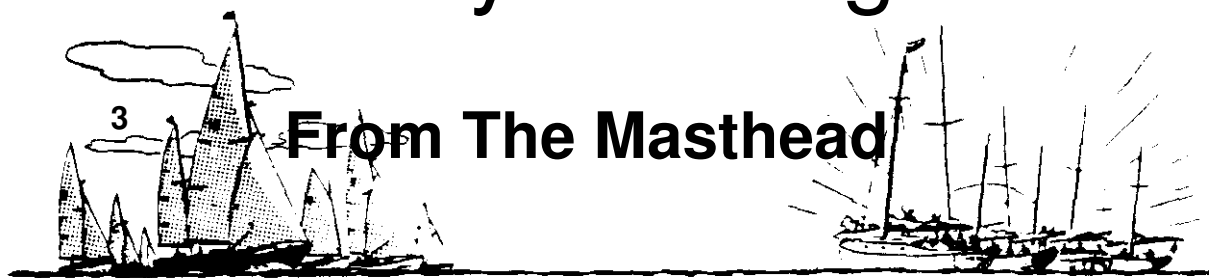

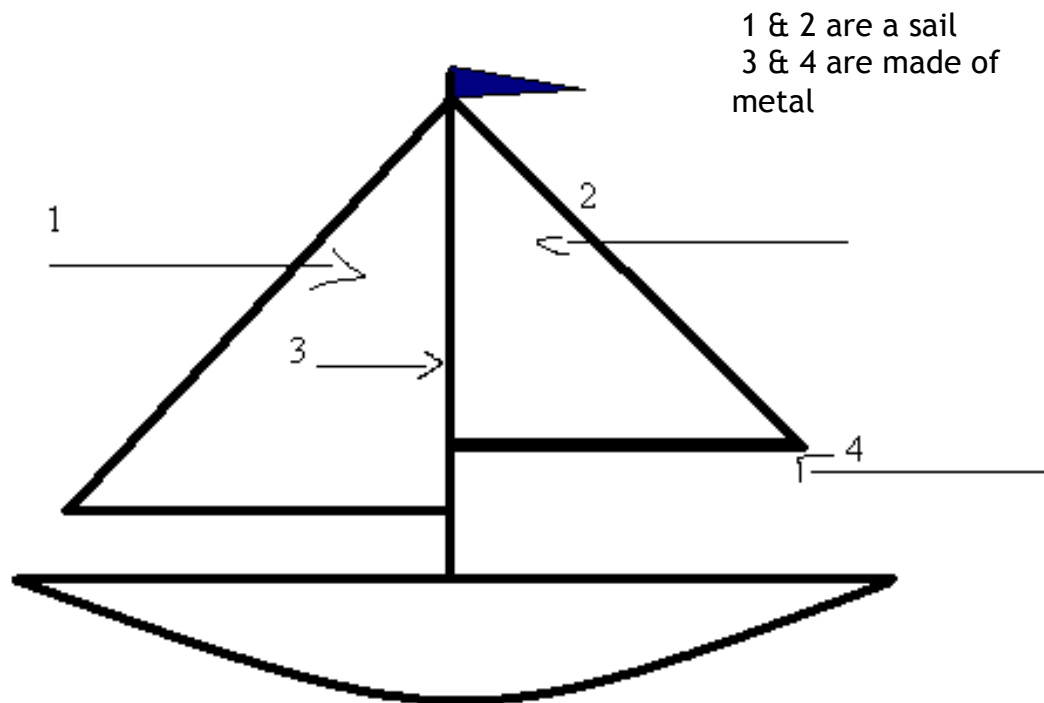

Report of Shoaling In Moriches Bay

There are 2 ways to head out to the eastern end of Long Island from the Great South Bay.

First is to go westward out of Fire Island Inlet. This is the preferred route for most sailing vessels.

It is also possible to go eastward through the south shore bays and canals (Bellport, Moriches, Shinnecock). This route is tricky, requires a precisely timed departure and constant vigilance. It is not recommended for deeper draft boats. Habanero draws 3'8", and we always go "inside" when heading out east. We've had our dramatic passages, but it takes 6 hours to get from Browns River to Shinnecock, compared to the day and a half it takes us to go via Fire Island Inlet.

As we are making preparations for the 2 week cruise (leaving June 21st), we began hearing the usual warnings about shoaling along the inside route. Lady Barbara (Levitsky) hailed us over the Memorial Day weekend to report rumors of worse than usual shoaling in Moriches Bay.

Fortunately, the face of the tow boat operators has changed over the past several years. In the past, you could swear the various tow boat operators were lying in wait - like ambulance chasers - just waiting for a mishap to occur. Now, they are in full customer service mode and are willing to provide all sorts of advice and support.

A quick call to Tow Boat Moriches confirmed severe shoaling right in front of the Coast Guard Station between buoys 26 and 27. Apparently the sand has encroached on the marked channel to 3'6", however, it is supposedly a little deeper to the EAST of the marked buoys.
