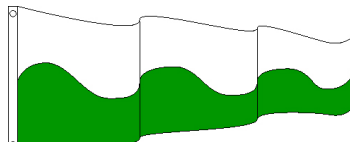
We now have the ability to order apparel from Landsend.com and have our SBCC logo embroidered.

Location. The following area is a safety zone: All navigable waters of Patchogue Bay, NY bounded by an area beginning at a point on land in Patchogue, NY at approximate position 40[deg]44'56" N, 073[deg]00'49" W; then running south to a point in Patchogue Bay at approximate position 40[deg]44'29" N, 073[deg]00'49" W; then running south east to a point in Great South Bay at approximate position 40[deg]43'47" N, 072[deg]59'54" W; then running east to approximate position 40[deg]43'53" N, 072[deg]58'46" W; then to approximate position 40[deg]43'57" N, 072[deg]57'06" W; then north to a point on land at approximate position 40[deg]44'29" N, 072[deg]57'09" W. All coordinates are North American Datum 1983.

Enforcement Period. This rule will be enforced from 11am to 5pm on August 22, 23 and 24, 2008

The Long Island Maritime Museum hosted the annual *Old Timer's Regatta* in conjunction with the *Vintage Boat Show* on Saturday, July 12. This year, Dick and Diane LaBella and I served as race committee on *Blaze*. We were also joined by Jeff Jacobi from the United States Wood Pussy Class Association in New Jersey. Tony Deloia, Fleet Captain of the North East Wood Pussy Association furnished the following report of the event.

“Several catboats, including two Herreshoff 18's a Marshall 18 and a Marshall Sandpiper 15 competed as did the L.I.M.M.'s recently built Gil Smith designed South Bay Cat This replica was ably skippered by Josh Herman, restoration shipwright at L.I.M.M. Unfortunately the gaff jaws parted during the race, so this beauty withdrew.

Phil Linker of Sayville Yacht Club won the catboat division in his Marshall Sandpiper 15 Mark Stang took top honors in the Narrasketuck fleet in this two race competition. The ‘Tuck’ was designed in 1935 by Long Island boat builder Wilbur Ketchum. Indigenous to Long Island, approximately thirty ‘Tucks’ sail in active competition on the Great South Bay.

John Quinn, with son Jack as able crew and bailer, in *Black Cat* took two ‘bullets’ as four fierce Wood Pussy competitors participated in the typical Great South Bay chop and 12- 15knot breezes. Bill Madsen in *Popcat* was 2nd, Tony Deloia in *Simba* was 3rd, and Kai Madsen sailing Antoine Bourel's planked wood pussy *Ty Punch* (donated to L.I.M.M. in May) finished 4th. We're looking forward to having Antoine join us in future events to show the ‘trick’ to sailing his former 1940's wood pussy.”

Last year we had six PHRF boats in the *Old Timer's Regatta*, although this year there none. We should make a special effort to get some SBCC boats involved next year. The after race awards presentation and barbeque along with the *Vintage Boat Show* and a number of exhibits and presentations provide a day long festive event. We also expect to have access to the marina for sailboats after a serious dredging project this winter.

The GSBYRA Race Week kicked off a few days later at the Bellport Bay Yacht Club. The Thursday and Friday evening races were started right off the dock with favorable 8- 10 knot S/W winds. Great for the all spinnaker fleet. All weekend races, except Optimists, were started from one committee boat and finished from another on opposite sides of the pin. This made for a great weekend of exciting sailing in the 24 knot winds. A very special thank you to Bellport Bay Yacht Club for hosting this event and for providing their time and energy to make it work so well. Race Week should be an important part of the season for all of us and greater participation would improve it all clubs on the bay. If you have any suggestions on how to improve Race Week, please let us know.

Finally, Babylon Yacht Club will be running the annual Louis Orr Regatta on Sunday, October 5, at 1300 hrs. This event is one of the most meaningful and traditional regattas on the bay. The festive atmosphere at the reception to celebrate the race and remember Louis Orr is always memorable. Please mark your calendar now with this revised date and be sure to join us.

President Bush Signs Clean Boating Act Legislation

Recently, President Bush signed S. 2766, "The Clean Boating Act of 2008," which permanently restores a long-standing exemption for recreational boats from permitting requirements under the Clean Water Act. Boat U.S. worked with the National Marine Manufacturers Association and a coalition of stakeholders as well as a bipartisan group of House and Senate legislators. "However, the real success of this campaign rests squarely on the shoulders of this country's millions of recreational boaters and anglers," said Boat U.S. Vice President of Government Affairs and US SAILING member Margaret Podlich. "Without their loud collective voice, we would not have reached this momentous event."

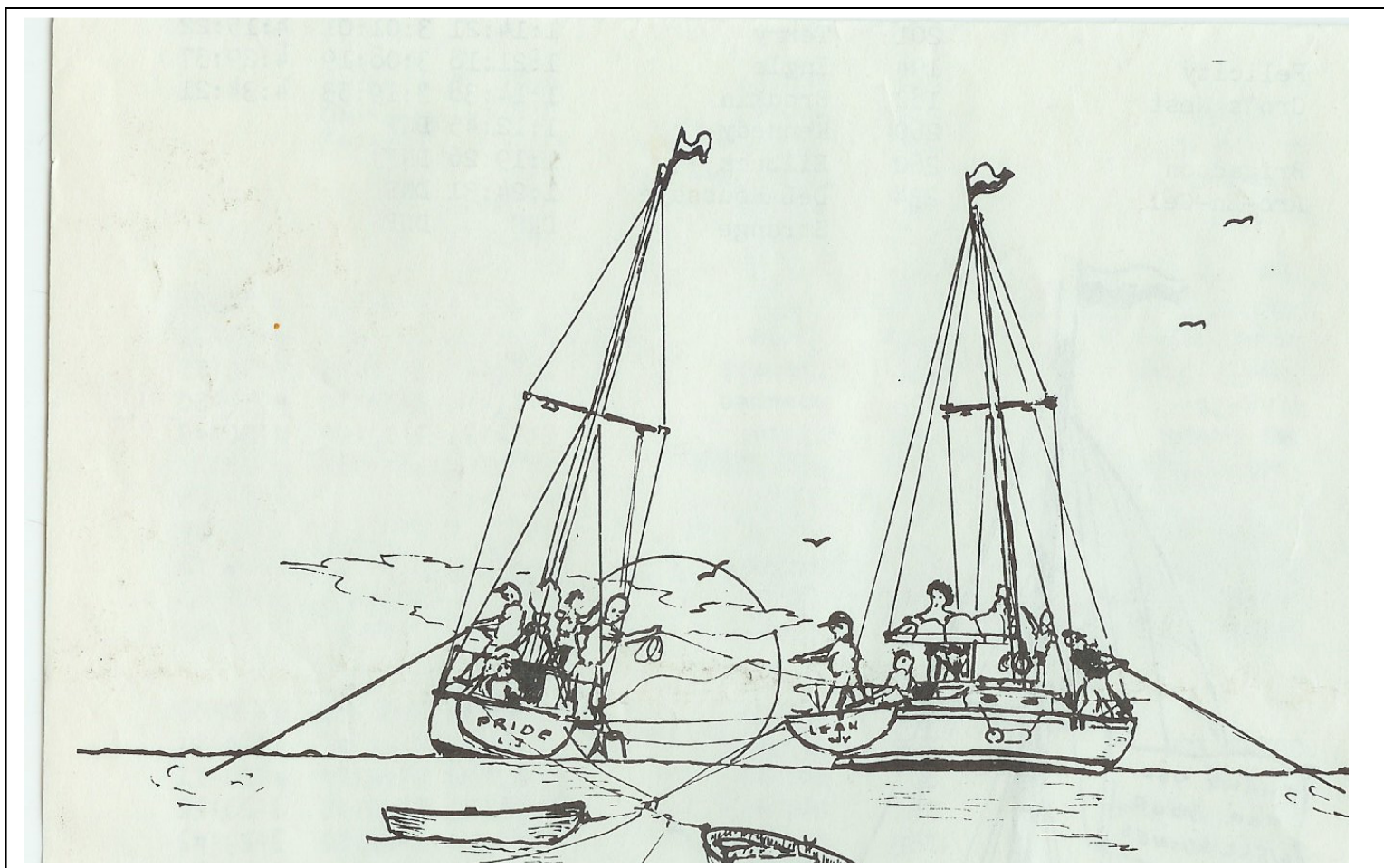
