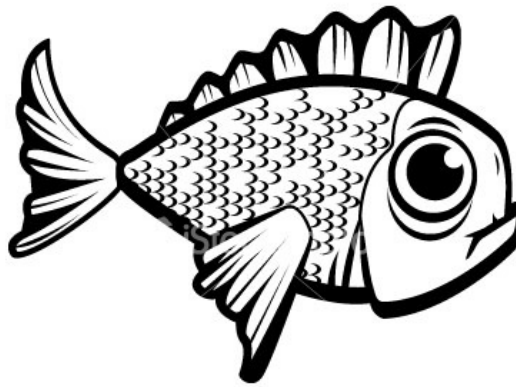

(nudge, nudge, wink, wink). Barbara Levitsky, Laurie & Dennis & Adrian Krug joined us by land. While we were there, a member of Bellport Bay YC invited anyone who was interested to race - a nice touch. A bunch of us went up to Alvino's Italian Table for dinner. FYI - Alvino's is formerly the Old Inlet Inn and is owned by the former owners of the Chowder Pot. Food was good, service OK

10 PM - Wind is calm out of the Northwest (as NOAA had predicted). There is lightening all around us, but no thunder.

Tuesday August 12 - Bellport to Atlantique
Everyone is off early to Atlantique.

I'm awakened by *della.calm* calling *Arcadia* - Della's having water pump problems. Bob Sheppard is able to fix this pretty easily and we all leave Bellport on a Northwest reach. I'm at 6 kts with the jib and the iron genny at just above stall.

By 2 PM I've counted 31 SBCC boats at Atlantique

Mistress has called to say she's had engine problems and is sailing to her slip and will catch up to us ASAP.

Around 3 pm the wind switches to SW - chilly and cloudy but a great time to visit. At some point I counted 29 sailboats and power boats from the SBCC.,

Phoebe Rose arrived with a bang. And that's all I'm going to say.

Two highlights of the day - Sally & Bill Eilbeck's infamous BBQ and the introduction of Reese Ryanne LaTorre to the rest of the club.

Evening activities included Scrabble aboard *della.calm*, and a toenail painting party aboard *Belle Free*.

The wind back off around 9 pm for a cool and pleasant evening.

Wednesday August 13 - Atlantique
We awoke to a light wind coming out of the North.

There were three "competeing" sand castle teams and the results were Mike & Kayla and Laura & Adrian Krug won for the small castles, Elizabeth DiSimone and her team won the mid-size castle and the winners of the large castle category were John & Cathy Trotta and Gail Palioscio as builders with Rich Palioscio as site superintendant.

Everyone was off on their own for the rest of the day and dinner.

Around 2:15 am (Thursday) I awoke to a cat crying. As I was waking I knew I didn't have a cat aboard, but the Holwells, next to me did. I poked my head out of the cabin and saw that Gerry Holwell was trying to figure out where the crying was coming from as well. I got off my boat, followed the poor crying and found a kitten hanging on to the rudder of *Wind Call* and crying for

help. I ran to *Miss Liberty II*, grabbed the crab net that Nancy keeps on her boat and tried to save the poor creature. At some point I called to Gerry for assistance and at another point Dick Parker appeared on the scene. The cat left the rudder and I was able to pull her out of the water. Gerry supplied a blanket and his cell phone to call the phone number on the cat's collar. After a while Barbara Nielsen came off her boat with a towel. My thought was, "It's Barbara's cat." Gerry confessed later he wondered why Barbara was going for a shower at 2 AM. As Barbara passed us she said she couldn't stop to talk, her cat was visiting somewhere. Of course it was her cat in my arms. Barbara was as shocked as the cat. We all went back to bed and Jack treated us to freshly baked corn muffins the following morning.

We left Atlantique to head to Oak Island Lead and Coast Guard Cove. Charlie Becker and Gerry Holwell led a group of boats through the bascule (draw) bridge. *Miss Liberty II* led *Esprit*, *Charisma*, *Lady Barbara (L)* and *Silhouette* into the Lead while *Becky*, *Galatea*, *Gracie Rose*, *Midnight Sun*, *Magic Dragon*, *della.calm*, *Loon*, *Mistress*, *Njord*, *Wild Blue II*, *Cee-J2*, *Arcadia*, *Phoebe Rose*, *Ceo na Mara*, *Carefree*, *Lady Barbara (N)* joined me in Coast Guard Cove. It was another one of those days. Plans for the evening - dinner on *della.calm* or a dinghy ride to Captree - and constant updates from NOAA about thunder storms. In Coast Guard Cove I was tying objects on pieces of Styrofoam noodles for the scavenger hunt for Friday and waiting for our 6 PM dinner time and watching storms go north and east of us.

Around 5:30 NOAA beeped and sounded its bad weather alarm once again, but this time there was a black cloud hovering over the barrier beach with fingers stretching into the ocean. I'm no meteorologist, but I had a feeling this did not bode well for a 6 PM dinner. It wasn't long before the thunder, lightening, wind and rain started. I was still working on Friday activities in the cabin and was pretty unaware of what was happening outside until Corinne got on the radio and said, "Wow! It's started! *Arcadia* is free. *Belle Free* up on deck! *Belle Free* up on deck!" I went into the cockpit to see *Arcadia* only a couple of yards off my starboard side. Bob hollered to me that he was holding, but still too close to me for comfort for anyone. I ran back down, put on my pfd and started the engine (which should have been running) and somehow dodged his anchor line and mine as well. During all of this I must have re-set my anchor because when this round was finished I was north of *Arcadia*, instead of south where I had been a half hour before. I kept trying to call another boat to make sure I was set as the rain (people later told me there was hail as well) was so strong I couldn't see. But I felt OK about what was happening and went down below - I now understand the phrase soaked through to the skin. At some point I went down below and got my foul weather jacket on. It seemed like only a few minutes later that I was looking out the port and saw *della.calm* rafted with *Phoebe Rose* coming down on me from the south. This was scarier than *Arcadia* - there were two boats and in their attempts to move were crossing over my anchor line. They passed me safely, and got the raft broken. *Della* was able to get away, but *Phoebe Rose's* anchor ended up under *Belle Free*. By this time most of the storm had passed and I was able to pull my boat forward on the anchor line until *Phoebe Rose* could get her anchor up.

I was thinking during all of this, "This is déjà vu all over again - we did this last year!" And Don & Marion Metznik must have felt the same way as they were beached by the storm - just like last year

Once the storm passed I re-set my anchor properly and Carole Sheppard called to say her daughter was at Jones Beach and the show was postponed because another storm was coming through. Well, it didn't seem as bad, but dinner was clearly ruined. I managed to get hold of someone on *Miss Liberty* around 9:30 PM - they'd had a nice dinner at Captree and were a little wet from the shower on the way back to the Lead, but other than that, they were OK.

I'm not sure about everyone else, but after a couple of cocktails and a whole box of instant

macaroni and cheese I finally went to sleep - still debating about setting the noodles for the scavenger hunt. Not to mention, my head is not working right...

I'd kept my VHS on 9 for most of the week - I think I turned it off when we were at the dock at Atlantique - so I was awakened at 7:30 Friday morning when Magic Dragon and Silhouette were talking about going home and not wanting to wake me. I got on the radio and told them I was awake and curious about what was going on. Magic Dragon, Silhouette, and Carefree were on their way home. As I was brushing my teeth other boats in the cove were chatting about going home. I got in the dinghy and rowed over to the Fleet Captain to suggest we end the cruise early as the forecast was the front we were in had stalled and wasn't expected to move until Saturday night. Needless to say, everyone else had heard the same thing and was thinking the same thing - HOME, ASAP! I went around the cove and asked the skippers what they wanted to do - three wanted to stay, three were undecided and the rest just had had enough and wanted to go anywhere else. I declared the cruise over at 8 AM Friday morning and promised the survivors of Coast Guard Cove T-shirts. By the way - Cee J2, Arcadia and Wild Blue II informed me they were watching their anemometers and the gusts in the cove ranged from 40 to 45 mph during the height of the storm.

So, I aborted the cruise, Della cancelled the rendezvous and, of course, the weather for the rest of the weekend wasn't all that bad. But I think the lesson learned is that sometimes we have to err on the side of conservatism. We were lucky that no one was hurt; no boats were damaged, in spite of the weather. I've heard people say they don't want to go back to Coast Guard Cove, and I understand that, but let's remember - we're a club and when something goes wrong on one of our boats, everyone around is there to help. And ultimately we can't control Mother Nature, but we can learn to live with her...

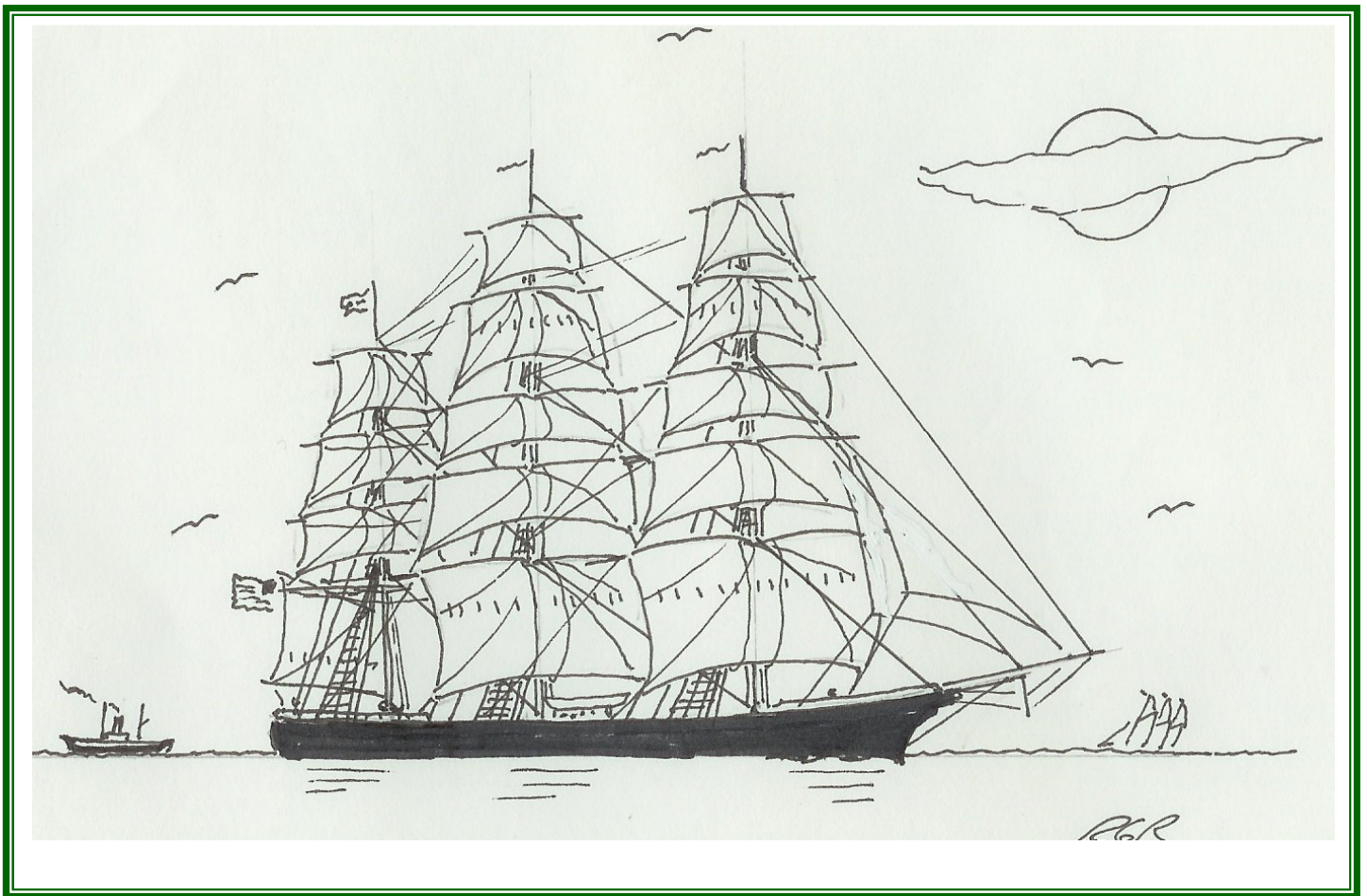
