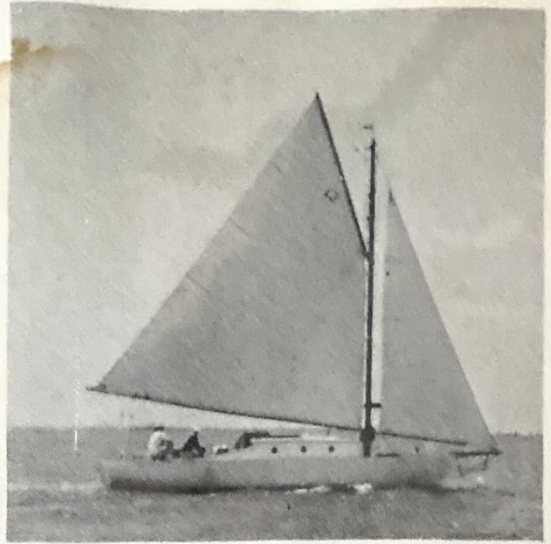

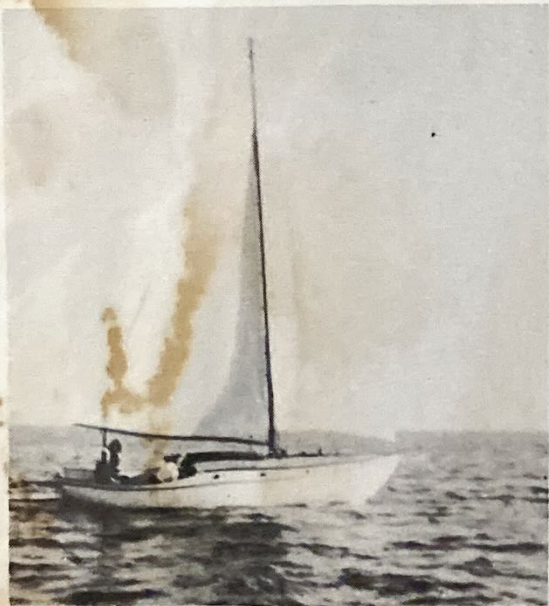

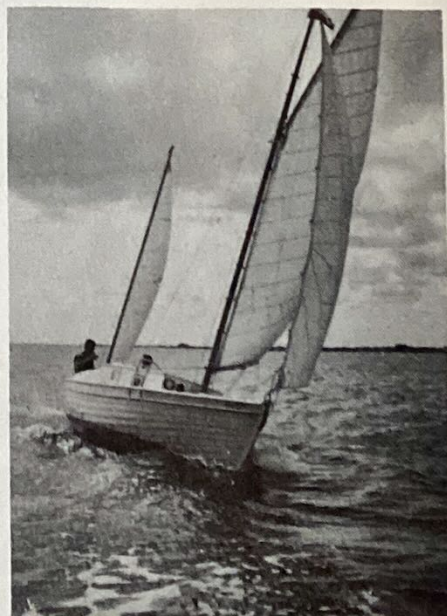

RACING INFORMATION

The S. B. C. C. handicap is based on the OFF-SOUNDINGS rule of 1960, plus an experience or performance factor combined on a 30% rate/70% experience ratio. Skippers sail 10 races to gain full performance allowance. Less than 10 is proportioned. Races in which late starts, groundings and rig failures result in slower than normal times, will not be counted.

The fleet is divided into five classes, three of the classes (A, B, C) are covered by the above rule. Class X races under Off-Soundings rate alone. Class S is a new class rated under the Storm Trysail rule and without the experience factor. Entrance to this class is by option. Owner must notify the Handicap Chairman.

Class assignments will be made by news letter. Boats without class assignment can receive one from the Regatta Committee before the race. All races are sailed under N.A.Y.R.U. rules except that boats may fly burgees or flags and the crew list is not limited by sail area.

Guns are at five minute intervals. Cone or flag will be lowered 30 seconds before each gun. Starting sequence is Warning gun, Preparatory gun, Class C start, Class B start, Class A start, Class X start, Class S start.

Recall and other signals will be flown from the race committee boat and will be announced by two guns. Signal flag "O" (red and yellow) means race called off. Signal flag "S" (white field, blue square) means course shortened, finish here. Signal flag "P" (blue field, white square) means start postponed. Warning gun fired 30 seconds after signal is lowered means postponements for 15 minute periods.

GSBYRA Regatta Week races will be held on the 28, 29, and 30 of June, 1962. Courses will be handed out by the Race Committee Boat, "Sunara."

$L = \frac{2 \times LWL - LOA}{3}$ D - Displacement

No beam correction or rig factor.

COURSES

BAY SHORE INVITATION: WARNING Gun -- 1300. Start established by Committee Boat off Lawrence Creek; to Nun No. 6, East of Captree Bridge; to Red Flashing No. 4, off Nicoll Point; return to finish line, leaving Flashing No. 1, off Bayberry Point, Islip, to starboard. Leave all other marks to Port.

LADIES' DAY RACE: Time and course to be announced.

BABYLON INVITATION: WARNING Gun -- 1300. Start established by Committee Boat off the Babylon Yacht Club; through the center span of Captree

Bridge to Flashing Red No. 2, South of Champlin Creek, Islip, leaving Nun No. 6 and Flashing Red No. 10 to Starboard; to Black and White S-L Flasher off Great Cove, Bay Shore; return to finish through the center span of the Bridge. Leave all marks to Port.

WEST ISLAND RACE: WARNING Gun -- 1300. Start established by Committee Boat in Nicoll Bay; passing around Red Flashing No. 10 off Bay Shore; Red-Black Quick Flash off Saltaire (keeping North of Flashing Red No. 8, regardless of which direction course is sailed); Flashing Green No. 15 off Point O'Woods; return to finish line established by Committee Boat in Nicoll Bay. All marks left to Port. Course may be sailed in the opposite direction, will all marks left to Starboard.

FOULKE TROPHY RACE: WARNING Gun -- 1800. Start established by Committee Boat in proximity of Flashing No. 7 in mid-Bay off Babylon Cove; through center span of Captree Bridge; keeping North of Flashing Red No. 32 off Patchogue Bay; round Flashing Green No. 1 off Howells Point to Port; returning up the Bay, keeping North of Flashing Red No. 32, through center span of Captree Bridge to finish at line established by committee boat off Babylon cove. Proper running lights must be observed.

SMITH TROPHY RACE: WARNING Gun -- 1400. Start established by Committee Boat off Sayville; to Flashing Red No. 18 off Point O'Woods; to Flashing Green RB No. 1 off Patchogue Bay; return to finish; leaving all marks to Port.

COMMODORE'S CUP RACE: WARNING Gun -- 1300. Start established by Committee Boat in Nicoll Bay; to Flashing Red No. 4 off Nicoll's Point leaving it to Port; to a finish line established by the Committee Boat in the vicinity of Howells Point.

SINGLE-HANDED CREEPSTAKES: Start and course to be announced.

GSBYRA RACE WEEK: Courses for Cruising Class Races will be in Race Week program.

CRUISING INFORMATION

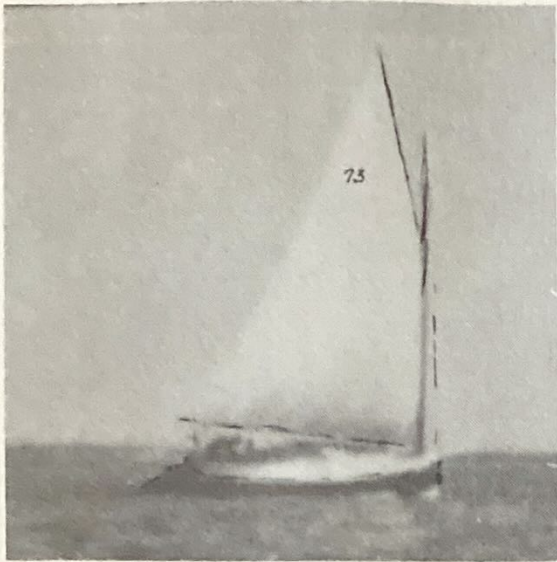
The 1962 Annual Cruise will rendezvous at Cormorant Point on Saturday, July 7. Skippers who can get away early will gather at Smith's Point Friday night for a head start down the bay on Saturday.

After passing through Shinnecock Canal, or taking the outside route around Montauk, the fleet will gather at Three Mile Harbor on Monday for three days of relaxing, fishing, gunk-holing, racing, lobstering, and the famous Children's Picnic.

One-week vacationers will start back to port on Thursday, July 12. Two or three-weekers will head east and north for Montauk, Block Island, Stonington, Conn., and the Fishers Island area.

The Annual Cruise, the GSBYRA Regatta Week, and Labor Day weekend at Bellport are designated as "Official" SBCC cruises. Skippers who participate in all three will be awarded a special medallion. There will also be a series of weekend rendezvous.

An Award will be given for the best Cruise log. All skippers who wish to enter this competition should keep a log of their cruises from Commissioning Day through the Fall Cruise. Award will be based on the extent and interest of cruising activities.



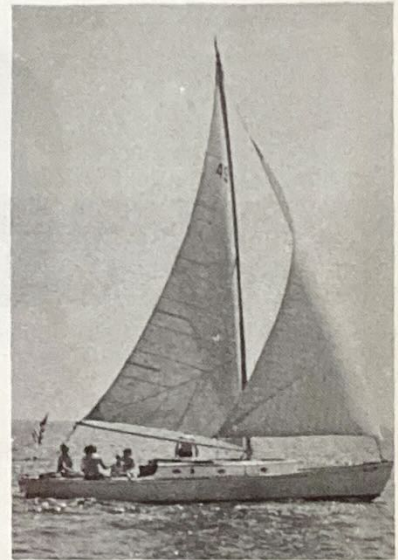

SUMMARY OF 1961 ACTIVITIES

Commodore Paterson (now retired) started the 1961 season with a literal bang, and hoisted the flag on the Brandy in the Commissioning Day ceremony, May 29. It blew hard from the North and a man or woman needed a stiff drink to stay alive. Nineteen boats made it, including Falcon, Golden Eagle, Gardaloo, Vi, Whimsy, Polaris, Golden Dragon, Spindrift, Brandy, Valkyrie, Sassenach, Tondelayo. Power boats: Merrybird, Cosset, Swansdown, Wahoo and Pontus.

BABYLON INVITATION -- JULY 1

It blew! If you'd like to verify the weather conditions, ask Bob Lawrence. One member of his starting crew finished the race in somebody else's boat. Order of finishes on corrected time:

Class A: Good Girl, Valkyrie, Noreaster, Lorelei, Polymer, Circe, Oriana, Periwinkle, Maumac, Harpoon, Winds Rush.

Class B: Scamper, Starbright, Falcon, Vi, Sea Witch, Sumaka III, Amberjack, Lady Lou V, Escape, Semiramis, Viking.

Class C: Shrimp, Cataumet, Jeanne, Betty, Brandy, Spindrift, Nancee, Polaris, Merry Ann, and Class X: Vivace.

LADIES' RACE -- JULY 9

The breeze was light and variable. Lady skippers brought the boats in as follows:

Class A: Maumac, Oriana, Noreaster, Lively Lady, Lorelei, Snark, Harpoon, Valkyrie.

Class B: Starbright, Vi, Falcon, Lady Lou, Star Dust, Sumaka III, Pegasus.

Class C: Nancee, Shrimp, and Class X: Vivace.

35 BOATS MAKE CRUISE

Twenty-one of the contingent made the scheduled rendezvous at Mystic seaport. Highlights include a memorable nor'easter going into Cormorant Point.
